

Standards of Conduct (Board Policy 2250)

As an evangelical Christian school, CAJ seeks not only to provide a Christian education in the classroom, but also to promote the spiritual welfare of its students and to maintain on campus an environment conducive to spiritual growth. The Academy, therefore, expects its board members, faculty, staff, and student body to endeavor to live in accordance with the teaching of our Lord Jesus Christ in matters of love, truth, purity, and reverence.

Since the Academy seeks always to maintain for itself a healthful, moral, and spiritual environment, it does not permit conduct such as intoxication, sexual misconduct, criminal involvement, thievery, cheating, profanity, deliberate destruction of property, or the possession or use of narcotics or pornographic materials.

The Academy does not permit the use of alcoholic beverages or tobacco on campus, at school-sponsored events, or in the neighborhood of the school. In situations away from school, parents are responsible for their children's behavior, but continued public disregard for the school's standards will result in administrative intervention and possible expulsion.

The Academy does not permit social dancing, other than square dancing, on campus or at school-related events.

It is expected that Sunday at the Academy will be observed as a day of worship and a day of rest from the week's activities. Informal recreation is permitted during the afternoon; organized competitive sports and co-curricular activities, other than music and drama related to church activities, are not.
